

Treasure Beach RV Park Family Tenting

RATE: \$50 per night for a family of 2 adults and up to three children.

Extra children \$2 per night/per child.

Extra Adult \$5 per night/per adult (Maximum 4 adults per site.)

Designated sites include water, electric, fire-ring with grill and one picnic table.

Reservations required.

Check-in Time is at 2:00 PM. Please be considerate of others and plan to arrive before 12:00 midnight (quiet time). All Renters must register with the office before setting up on a tent site and must not move from this designated site without permission from the Front Office.

Check-out time is before 12:00 noon.

Minimum/Maximum Stays: 2-Night minimum stay. 2-Week maximum stay in tenting area.

Reservation Deposits: A Non-Refundable two-night minimum deposit required within seven days of making reservations. Remaining balance is due upon arrival. CASH ONLY for balances of less than \$200. ATM available in front office.

Cancellation Policy: No Refunds for early check-outs.

Picnic Tables & Fire Rings: There is one picnic table and one fire-ring with adjustable cooking grill provided per tent site. Please do not move picnic tables or fire-rings from your campsite or another's campsite.

Visitors or Overnight Guests: No Visitors or Overnight Guests allowed to those availing themselves of the tenting area.

Vehicles: Only one vehicle permitted per tent site. All other vehicles must be parked in the overflow parking lot. Please display vehicle pass at all times on rear-view mirror. Turn pass in to office upon checking out. Posted speed limits of 10 mph must be observed. Car washing is not permitted.

Motorized Bikes, Motorized Scooters, ATVs, Golf Carts, Segways, etc: Unlicensed motor-bikes and/or motorized scooters, ATVs, Segways and golf carts are prohibited in Treasure Beach RV Park. Licensed Motorcycles may be used for ingress and egress only to sites, but may not be driven around the Park grounds.

Bicycles: Bicycles are an encouraged mode of transportation throughout the Park. They are economical, environment friendly and a part of a healthy lifestyle. Delaware State Law requires that all children under the age of sixteen wear a helmet.

Boats, Boat trailers, Jet skis, Utility Trailers: Boats, boat trailers, jet skis and utility trailers are not permitted within tenting area. They must be placed in the overflow parking area or boat storage area if space available and must be marked with a Treasure Beach ID tag (available in the front office).

Pet Policy: Pets are welcomed, but must be kept on a leash and do not disturb others. Pets cannot be left unattended at any time. Pets must have current rabies vaccinations and ID tags. There is a Pet walk area across the road from tenting area. Pet owners are responsible for cleanup.

Bathhouse: Bathhouse with hot showers is located across the parking lot.

Quiet Hours: Midnight to 8:00 a.m. Please be considerate of your neighbors – no loud music or talking, or other noise between these hours. Excessive noise and/or objectionable language will not be tolerated and can be cause for eviction from the premises – without a refund.

Campfires: Fires are permitted in proper fireplaces and are to be supervised by adults. Fire-rings with adjustable grills for cooking are provided on each site. Campfires are permitted from 8:00 a.m. to midnight. Please never leave a fire unattended. Fire extinguishers are located at Front Office, the General Store and Maintenance Office. Firewood is available at the camp store. All fires are to be put out by midnight and debris cleaned up.

Playground & Skateboard Park: Adult supervision is required in playground area. Helmet, knee and elbow pads must be worn to use Skate Park. No bicycles, scooters, food or drink, or smoking allowed inside of Skate Park. Children under 8 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

Crabbing/Fishing Pier & Lake Redbeard: The crabbing/fishing pier is located at the point of Pirates Trail. Delaware law now requires a license to fish, clam or crab for anyone aged 16 yrs or older. Short-term fishing licenses are available at Captain Mac's Bait & Tackle across the street from Treasure Beach RV Park. Swimming or boating is not allowed in Lake Redbeard.

Pools: Treasure Beach RV Park has two lifeguarded Olympic sized pools, plus a toddler pool. Pools are open every day, (hours are posted on gate) from Memorial Day to Labor Day, weather permitting.
