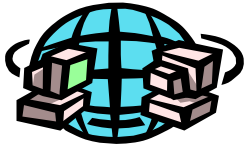

From The Manager's Desk

Whew! It's been HOT! That's why you need to come to the beach. Great way to cool off.

We are happy to announce that the paddle boats located at Lake Red Beard are now available for rent from 10a to 6p, Thursdays through Mondays for only \$5 per hour. One must be sixteen or older to rent a paddle boat. Children under sixteen must be accompanied by an adult. Life vests are required by all. So go over and say "Hi!" to Ryan and have fun!

Speaking of Lake Red Beard, yes, you need a fishing license at Lake Red Beard. According to Delaware Natural Resources Environmental Control, a fishing license is required for those age sixteen and over.

There have also been some questions regarding Delaware laws on mopeds. In the State of Delaware, mopeds are required to be titled and registered before they can be operated on Delaware roads, and you must have a valid drivers license to operate one. You can use them for ingress and egress only in Treasure Beach.

We are in the process of checking seasonal records in preparation of next season's renewals. You may find your keycards temporarily off If we have a question or two, or if you have not updated your required information recently. If you have moved within the past year, have purchased a new car, boat or rv, or have been blessed with a new child or spouse in your life, please stop in the office and request to update your folder.

Those seasonals who still owe for unregistered guest fees, trash bags on coves, grass cutting, etc., or have yet to submit pertinent documentation such as RV

titles will not be renewed for next season until the problem is remedied.

We will begin to accept deposits after Labor Day, if you have been rolled over into the next season. 2012 rates have yet to be decided, but we will inform you as quickly as possible as soon as we know.

Typically, many seasonals, especially those with school children, will start to winterize and close down for the season around the end of the month. So we would like to remind everyone that boats or boat trailers currently parked in the west front field must be removed by October 15, 2011. Nothing can be stored in this area during the off-season. If you store your boat in Treasure Beach during the winter months, it must be stored directly on your site and not in or at the end of any of the cove roads.

We would like to Thank Yvonne and Stu Moore, who played the Bluegrass music at our Craft and Flea Market held on Saturday, July 9th. The music was wonderful and well appreciated. The event was well attended and we appreciate the members of Trinity Cathedral for hosting the event. Thank you!

Dickens Parlour Theatre in Millville, DE

Do you love magic?

There is a new theater located off of Route 26 in Millville, DE (across from the Giant Supermarket) named Dickens Parlour Theatre owned by a professional magician, Richard Bloch.

This beautiful, small, charming, intimate Victorian theater puts on up-close-and-personal magic shows for the entire family every night at 7:00 PM. Occasionally, if the need arises they add a second evening show, and on rainy days, they have a 2:00 PM matinee.

The theater looks like a typical family parlor during the English Victorian era. The theater is named after the famous writer Charles Dickens, an amateur magician who was fascinated with illusions and "parlour tricks." Richard Bloch is hoping to recreate that magical fantasy here at the beach.



The theater seats comfortably 50 people. Your family will be treated to a 55-minute magical presentation by award winning magicians from around the world with demonstrations running from the slight of hand, death-defying illusions, to mystifying acts of magic, all blended with hilarious smart wit and magical prowess.

Bloch is not a stranger to his well-loved hobby of magic. His fascination for magic began when he was a small child, when he worked after school at a local magic shop near where he lived. His fascination eventually turned into a career of magic. He has traveled around the world, and has performed magic in Las Vegas, at the famed Magic Castle in Hollywood, and on cruise ships for years. Bloch has also invented his own illusions, and his techniques and apparatus has been used by David Copperfield, the late Doug Henning, Siegfried and Roy, and Harry Blackstone, Jr.

Magicians change weekly, so there is always a new performance to return to. Don't be

surprised if you are asked to be a part of the performance, which adds to a lot of the fun.

The prices are very reasonable: \$12 for children under fifteen, and \$18 for adults, and children fifteen or older. Reservations can be made by calling 302-829-1071, or online by visiting their website at DPTMAGIC.com.

The theatre can be a little difficult to find, but is located at 35715 Atlantic Avenue, Millville, DE. All seats are good, but get there early for a front row seat. Parking is free.

Highly recommended for families at the beach!

The theater has also just added a new café for your convenience.

During the month of August, John Cassidy will be performing on August 4—7th, Richard Bloch on the

8 and 9th, and also from the 17th to the 21st. Francis Menotti will perform on August 10th and the 14th to the 16th.

There will also be a slight diversion from magic as a special performance will be given by the award-winning actor Jim Brochu, partnered with Richard Bloch, in a reading of Neil Simon's hilarious "The Sunshine Boys." Jim and Rich will dine with you after the show in the Parlour. This one-time, super special performance will be held on August 13th at 6:30 PM and is \$45 per seat.

Well worth a visit!

Restaurant View

Just Hooked in Fenwick Island, DE

Being local residents, we were delighted to hear of a new, interesting and hip restaurant open in Fenwick Island, DE. Just Hooked is a welcome change of pace from the usual fried food joints common in Fenwick island and Ocean City.



Located right on Route 1, Just Hooked opened its doors on Memorial Day Weekend, in the old Quail Restaurant in the Sunshine Shopping Center, and customers have been piling in since. The restaurant, which seats 150 inside and outside, is spacious, open and inviting with a relaxed atmosphere. The décor is modern, tasteful, light, and the outside deck makes for a pleasant outdoor dining experience. They have a comfortable bar in the center of the restaurant, and an open kitchen. The night we visited, they had live music which added to the experience.

The slogan for the restaurant is "Farm-Ocean-Table" in that the owner uses produce from local farmers and watermen, supporting the local economy, and the customer gets the freshest ingredients. There is a bulletin board on the wall listing the many local businesses they use.

The food is simple, but amazing! I ordered the Crab Louie as a salad, and it was the best I have ever eaten! I also ordered the Salmon which was deliciously seasoned and tender. The dish was accompanied by grilled asparagus, which was also the best I have ever had in my life. My mother ordered the special for the evening of Rock Fish. The sauce was delicious! My friends who have also visited the restaurant have recommended the scallops, mahi mahi, jalapeno crab bisque, shrimp tacos, crab cakes and the calamari. And I have been told that the desserts are to die-for! I have yet to hear of anyone saying they didn't like the food they ate. Prices are reasonable.

The service was impeccable, (Corey was our waitress) and the owners and managers come around to make sure your dining experience was enjoyable.

Opens daily at 11:30 a.m. for lunch or dinner. Definitely a place to add to your favorite list!

Don't forget the annual TBRV PigNic on Saturday, August 13!

Please make sure you sign up at the Front Office if you are planning on attending the Annual Pignic. You will receive a Give-away ticket upon sign-up. There are also sign-up sheets for anyone who wishes to volunteer the day of the event. Your help is appreciated.

Please bring your covered dishes and food creations to the Pavilion between 3:30 and 4:00 PM, as we cannot hold food too long. (Please do not bring food prior to that time.) All food must be in disposable containers, as we cannot save dishes and utensils for you.

The line for the meal usually starts pretty early, and we begin serving at 4 PM sharp. We wish to give everyone a chance to go thru the food line one time, before allowing anyone to come up for seconds or thirds. Dinner service ends at 5:30 PM.

There will be a Limbo, Hula Hoop and Best Dressed Contests during the evening with prizes awarded.

Sign-up sheets will be located at the front office for the Swap and Drop.

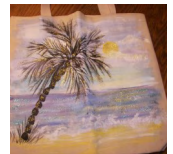
Painting Classes!
